Re: ICE Swap Trade, LLC - Rule Amendment - Amended Rulebook

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Commodity Exchange Act (the "Act") and Section 40.6(a) of the regulations of the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (the "Commission"), ICE Swap Trade, LLC ("IST" or the "SEF") hereby notifies the Commission that it has amended its Rulebook. The amendments contained herein have been made in order to clarify the process by which IST intends to implement and enforce certain of its rules, affect certain administrative/clerical revisions, and respond to guidance received from the Commission. The Rulebook will become effective on October 6, 2016 (based upon an acknowledged filing date of September 22, 2016).

A concise explanation of the amendments to the Rulebook is attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u>. A copy of the revised Rulebook marked to show changes against the Rulebook submitted to the Commission with an effective date of August 1, 2016, is attached hereto as <u>Exhibit B</u>, and a clean copy of the revised Rulebook is attached hereto as <u>Exhibit C</u>.
