CONCISE EXPLANATION AND ANALYSIS OF THE OPERATION, PURPOSE, AND EFFECT OF THE PROPOSED RULE AND ITS COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE ACT, INCLUDING CORE PRINCIPLES AND THE COMMISSION'S REGULATIONS THEREUNDER

Eurex Clearing is amending the Clearing Conditions and Price List to reflect the decision of the Management Board of Eurex Deutschland to introduce futures on the EURO STOXX 50[®] Realized Dispersion Index. Eurex Clearing will provide clearing services for these contracts. These contracts will be subject to CFTC certification pursuant to CFTC Rule 30.13(m) prior to being available for direct access trading from the United States.

Further information regarding the operation, purpose, and effect of the proposed amendments is discussed in the attached Eurex Clearing Circular 110/19, which is appended as Attachment A.

Eurex Clearing has identified the following derivatives clearing organization ("DCO") Core Principle as potentially being relevant to the above amendments:

DCO Core Principle C (Participant and Product Eligibility): The proposed amendments will
comply with DCO Core Principle C because the amendments list new contracts on Eurex
Deutschland, which are cleared by Eurex Clearing (though outside of its DCO license), and all
products cleared by Eurex Clearing under its DCO license will continue to be subject to
appropriate standards in compliance with this Core Principle.
