ICE Clear Credit (“ICC”) hereby submits, pursuant to Section 5c(c)(1) of the Commodity Exchange Act and Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“Commission”) Regulation 40.6(d), a notification of changes to risk parameters established by ICC in consultation with the ICC Risk Committee, Trading Advisory Group and/or Risk Working Group. ICC is registered with the Commission as a derivatives clearing organization.

The purpose of this notification is to report any changes to the risk parameters established by ICC. During the week ending December 16, 2022, changes were made to the following parameters:

- bid/offer widths for CDX and iTraxx credit indices and single name risk factors
- concentration charge thresholds for index and single name risk factors
- Kendall Tau rank-order correlations for NA, EU, Asia/Pacific (“AP”), and Emerging Market (“EM”) risk factors
- MAD estimates (inclusive of EWMA) for NA, EU, AP, and EM risk factors
- left and right tail parameters for NA, EU, AP, and EM risk factors

ICC has posted a copy of this submission on its website concurrent with this filing.
