The Board of Trade of the City of Chicago, Inc. ("CBOT" or "Exchange") hereby notifies the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") of plans to implement the Yield Futures APAC Broker Incentive Program ("Program"). The Program will become effective on March 1, 2024.

Exhibit 1 sets forth the terms of this Program.

CBOT reviewed the designated contract market core principles ("Core Principles") as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act ("CEA"). During the review, CBOT staff identified the following Core Principles as potentially being impacted: Monitoring of Trading, Execution of Transactions, Protection of Market Participants, Compliance with Rules, Availability of General Information, and Recordkeeping.

The Program will not impact the Exchange's ability to perform its trade practice and market surveillance obligations under the CEA and the Exchange's market regulation staff will monitor all trading in the Program's products to prevent manipulative trading and market abuse. Additionally, the Exchange has implemented systems to track Program participants' obligations to ensure proper distribution of earned incentives. The incentives in the Program do not impact the Exchange's order execution. Participants in the Program will be selected by Exchange staff using criteria as further stated in Exhibit 1. Chapter 4 of the CBOT rules includes prohibitions against fraudulent, noncompetitive, unfair or abusive practices. All participants must execute a contractual agreement with the Exchange in which each participant will expressly agree to comply with and be subject to, applicable regulations and CBOT rules. The Program is subject to the Exchange's record retention policies which comply with the CEA.

CBOT certifies that the Program complies with the CEA and the regulations thereunder. There were no substantive opposing views to this Program.

EXHIBIT 1

Yield Futures APAC Broker Incentive Program

Program Purpose

The purpose of this Program is to encourage brokers to increase volume which will enhance market liquidity for the products listed below. More liquid contracts on the CME Globex Platform ("Globex") benefit all participants in the market.

Product Scope

2-Year Yield Futures ("2YY"), 5-Year Yield Futures ("5YY"), 10-Year Yield Futures ("10Y"), and 30-Year Yield Futures ("30Y") that are traded on Globex ("Products").

Eligible Participants

There is no limit to the number of participants that may enroll in the Program. Participants may be CBOT members or non-members. Participants must be retail brokers operating in the APAC region that had clients trading Interest Rate futures during 2023.

Program Term

Start date is March 1, 2024. End date is August 31, 2024.

Hours

N/A

Obligations

<u>Volume Obligations</u>: Upon enrollment in the Program, each participant's average daily volume ("ADV") in the Products traded on Globex will be aggregated and measured from October 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023 ("Baseline ADV"). In order to be eligible to receive the incentives, participants must exceed their Baseline ADV during each calendar month.

Incentives

<u>Fee Credits</u>: Upon meeting the obligations, as determined by the Exchange, participants will receive fee credits of \$0.60 per side on all Globex volume in the Products above their Baseline ADV.

Monitoring and Termination of Status

The Exchange shall monitor activity and participants' performance and shall retain the right to revoke participant status if it concludes from review that a participant no longer meets the eligibility requirements or fails to meet the obligations of the Program.
