Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC” or “Commission”) Regulation 40.6(d), the Exchange submits this weekly notification of the following amendments related to product terms and conditions made effective during the week of April 8, 2024.

Effective April 14, 2024, and until further notice, the Exchange suspended the approved status for registration (warranting) for delivery and delivery of aluminum of Russian Federation origin that was produced on or after April 13, 2024, which currently includes the Aluminum Brands identified in the Exhibit A. The marketplace was alerted via Special Executive Report (“SER”) 9400, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

("COMEX" or "Exchange") has suspended the approved status for registration (warranting) for delivery and delivery of aluminum of Russian Federation origin that was produced on or after April 13, 2024, which currently include the Aluminum Brands identified in the table below.

Aluminum from these brands produced prior to April 13, 2024, will continue to be eligible for warranting and delivery against the Exchange's Aluminum Futures contract (CME Globex/CME ClearPort Code: ALI;

Rulebook Chapter 107). Aluminum from these brands produced on or after April 13, 2024 will not be eligible for warranting and delivery until further notice.

All participants must ensure their participation in delivery against the Exchange's Aluminum Futures contract complies with local laws and regulations, including applicable economic sanctions.

The Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC") will be notified of the aforementioned suspension via the weekly notification procedures set out in Part 40 of the CFTC's Regulations.
