Pursuant to Section 5c(c)1 of the Commodity Exchange Act, as amended (the “Act”) and Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“Commission”) Regulation 40.6(a), ICE Futures U.S., Inc. - Option on Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative Future Vintage 2019 (“RGR”)
