Dear Mr. Kirkpatrick:

Chicago Mercantile Exchange Inc. ("CME" or "Clearing House") hereby notifies the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") of plans to extend the fee waiver program supporting certain cleared-only over-the-counter ("OTC") foreign exchange ("FX") options products ("Program") through January 31, 2025. The extension of the Program will become effective on February 1, 2024. All other Program terms remain unchanged.

Exhibit 1 sets forth the terms of the Program. Modifications appear below, with additions underlined and deletions ~~overstruck~~.

CME reviewed the derivatives clearing organization core principles ("Core Principles") as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act ("CEA"). During the review, CME staff concluded that the following Core Principle applies to this submission:

Financial Resources: The Program will have a non-material impact on the financial resources of the Clearing House. As such, it will not prevent the Clearing House from demonstrating that it has adequate financial, operational, and managerial resources to discharge its responsibilities as a derivatives clearing organization.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the CEA and CFTC Regulation 40.6(a), the Exchange hereby certifies that this Program complies with the CEA, including regulations thereunder. There were no substantive opposing views to this proposal.

EXHIBIT 1

OTC FX Options Fee Waiver Program

Program Purpose

The purpose of this Program is to incentivize market participants to submit transactions in the OTC FX Options products listed below to the Clearing House for clearing. The resulting increase in volume benefits all participant segments in the market.

Product Scope

All cleared-only OTC FX Options (collectively, the "Products").

Eligible Participants

The temporary reduction in fees will be open to all market participants and will automatically be applied to any transaction in the Products submitted to the Clearing House for clearing.

Program Term

Start date is November 1, 2017. End date is ~~January 31, 2024~~ January 31, 2025.

Hours

The Program will be applicable regardless of the transaction time.

Incentives

Fee Waivers: All market participants that submit transactions in the Products to the Clearing House will have their clearing fees waived.
