Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC” or “Commission”) Regulation 40.6(d), the Exchange submits this weekly notification of the following amendments related to product terms and conditions made effective during the week of March 18, 2019.

Effective March 20, 2019, the Exchange approved the application for an increase in Soybean Oil regularity from Cargill, Inc. at their facility in Cedar Rapids, IA. The marketplace was alerted of the approval via MKR #03-20-19B, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
