Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC” or “Commission”) Regulation 40.6(d), the Exchange submits this weekly notification of the following amendments related to product terms and conditions made effective during the week of July 2, 2018.

Effective July 1, 2018, the Exchange approved all applications for declaration of regularity for the delivery of Corn, Soybeans, Soybean Oil, Soybean Meal, Wheat, Oats, and Rough Rice. The marketplace was alerted of these approvals via MKR# 07-02-18, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Also, effective July 1, 2018, the Exchange approved the regularity renewals of Hard Red Winter Wheat delivery facilities. The marketplace was alerted of this approval via MKR# 07-02-18B, which is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

Effective July 2, 2018, the Exchange approved applications from Cargill, Inc. for a decrease in regularity in Soybean Oil at its facilities located in Ackley, IA and Creve Coeur, IL. The marketplace was alerted of these approvals via MKR# 07-02-18C, which is attached hereto as Exhibit C.

Also, effective July 2, 2018, the Exchange approved an application from Solae LLC for a decrease in regularity in Soybean Oil at its facility located in Gibson City, IL. The marketplace was alerted of this approval via MKR# 07-02-18D, which is attached hereto as Exhibit D.

Also, effective July 2, 2018, the Exchange approved an application from Owensboro Grain Company, LLC for a decrease in regularity in Soybean Meal at its facility located in Owensboro, KY. The marketplace was alerted of this approval via MKR# 07-02-18E, which is attached hereto as Exhibit E.

Also, effective July 2, 2018, Erwin Keith, Inc. changed its clearing agent to Rosenthal Collins Group LLC for the firm’s transactions. The marketplace was alerted of this change via MKR# 07-02-18F, which is attached hereto as Exhibit F.

In accordance with the changes above, the Exchange updated the CBOT Rulebook Chapter 7 Facilities Chart ("Chart") for "SRW Wheat Mississippi River", "Corn and Soybeans", "Soybean Oil", and "Soybean Meal". The Chart is attached under separate cover, in blackline format, as Exhibit G.

Effective July 5, 2018, the Exchange made administrative amendments to Rule 49102. ("Floating Price") for the Urea (Prilled) FOB Yuzhny Swaps (Clearing Only) contract. The amendments do not affect the value or the floating price of the Contract. The marketplace was alerted of this change via SER# 8193R, which is attached hereto as Exhibit H.

SUBJECT: Administrative Amendments to the Urea (Prilled) FOB Yuzhny Swaps (Clearing Only) Contract

(This SER supersedes SER 8193 dated June 29, 2018, and is being issued to amend the Clearing Code of the Contract from UFN to UFZ. No other amendments have been made to the original SER).

Effective Thursday, July 5, 2018, The Board of Trade of the City of Chicago, Inc. ("CBOT" or "Exchange") will amend Rule 49102. ("Floating Price") of the Urea (Prilled) FOB Yuzhny Swaps (Clearing Only) contract (Rulebook Chapter 49; Clearing Code: UFZ) (the "Contract"). The amendments are administrative in nature and will not affect the value nor the floating price of the Contract.

Specifically, ICIS has advised the Exchange that the name of the reference price for its Urea prilled bulk assessment will change from "Urea prilled bulk Yuzhny FOB" to "Urea prilled bulk Black Sea FOB."

Amendments to Rule 49102. are provided below in blackline format.

CBOT Rulebook Chapter 49 Urea (Prilled) FOB Yuzhny Swaps (Clearing Only)

49102. FLOATING PRICE

The Floating Price for each contract month shall be based on price assessments for "Urea prilled bulk Yuzhny Black Sea FOB" published weekly by ICIS during the contract month and price assessments for "Urea prilled bulk Yuzhny fob" published weekly by Profercy during the contract month, as described in paragraph (A) below.

[The remainder of the Rule is unchanged.]

Note that this is simply a name change only and is not a change in the historical underlying methodology used by ICIS.
