Re: Delisting of Certain ICE Futures U.S. Option on Futures Products - Submission Pursuant to Section 5c(c)(1) of the Act and Regulation 40.6(a)

Dear Mr. Kirkpatrick:

Pursuant to Section 5c(c)1 of the Commodity Exchange Act, as amended (the "Act") and Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("Commission") Regulation 40.6(a), ICE Futures U.S., Inc. ("Exchange") submits notice to the Commission that, effective as of the close of business today, October 7, 2022, the Exchange will delist all contract months of the following option on futures contracts, unless otherwise noted:

- Option on Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative Future Vintage 2020 ("RGS")
- Option on Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative Future Vintage 2021 ("RGT")
- Option on Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative Future Vintage 2022 ("RGU") (Delisting expirations after Dec22)
- Option on Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative Future Vintage 2023 ("RJ3")
- Option on PJM Tri Qualified Renewable Energy Certificate Class I Future ("PPR") (Delisting expirations after Jul23)

The delisted contract months of the option on futures products currently have no open interest. No additional contract months will be listed for the RGU and PPR contracts. The Exchange notes that it is listing for trade date October 10, 2022, new option on futures contracts to supplement the delisted RGU, RJ3, and PPR option on futures contracts and contract months. (*Please see Submission Nos. 22-167 through 22-169.*)
