Pursuant to Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC” or “Commission”) Regulation 40.6(d), the Exchange submits this weekly notification of the following amendments related to product terms and conditions made effective during the week of October 24, 2022.

Effective October 27, 2022, the Exchange approved the applications for an increase in Soybean Meal regularity for Cargill, Inc. at their Bloomington, IL, Iowa Falls, IA and Sioux City, IA facilities. Additionally, the Exchange approved the applications for an increase in Soybean Oil regularity for Cargill, Inc. at their Lafayette, IN and Bloomington, IL facilities. The marketplace was alerted of the changes via MKR #10-27-22, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Also, effective October 27, 2022, the Exchange approved the application for an increase in Corn and Soybeans regularity for Cargill, Inc. at their Havana, IL facility. The marketplace was alerted of the change via MKR #10-27-22B, which is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

In accordance with the changes above, the Exchange updated the CBOT Rulebook Chapter 7 “Facilities” spreadsheet (“Spreadsheet”) for “Soybean Meal,” “Soybean Oil” and “Corn and Soybeans.” The Spreadsheet is attached under separate cover, in blackline format, as Exhibit C.
