The OTC Market Perspective

Carbon market incubator

- Compliance instruments trade OTC before adoption by regulated exchanges
 - European Union Allowances (EUAs)
 - California Carbon Allowances (CCAs)

Innovation in risk management

- OTC market participants tackle difficult risk challenges
 - Options for compliance instruments
 - Offsets for compliance use (CERs & CCOs)




Current OTC Derivatives Markets for Carbon

- Well developed OTC carbon derivatives market for established compliance programs
 - Largely dealer/customer transactions mirroring exchange-cleared market
 - Exchange listed-contracts for hedging OTC positions
- Mature OTC market for spot and forward delivery
 - o Focus on bespoke structures and lowering transaction costs
 - New carbon trading platforms



Evolving Carbon Offset Market

- Largely spot trades for physical delivery or forward purchases of long-term strips of credits
- Lack of standardization: "Beauty in the eye of the beholder"
- Manage risk through contracting
- New project development





Future Considerations: Climate Change


- Extreme weather events lead to price volatility and raise market structure issues
- Long-term shifts in liquidity (commodities, venues, products)
 - o Power & natural gas basis markets
 - o Global LNG markets
 - o Carbon markets
 - Renewable energy certificate markets
- Emerging trading strategies based on climate impacts amplify trends
- Carbon pricing will play important role
