DEFENDANT ROBERT ESCOBIO IN CONTEMPT**


The Court has been notified by the Plaintiff CFTC that Defendant Robert Escobio has failed to comply with this Court's Order entered March 18, 2019 (D.E. 281) as of approximately 3 p.m. March 29, 2019.

Exhibit 2 attached to the Notice received from the CFTC (D.E. 296-2) reflects statements received from Mr. Escobio's counsel that Escobio is "prepared to voluntarily appear." It is therefore **ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DEECREED** that Defendant's request to voluntarily surrender be and the same is hereby **GRANTED**.

It is further **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that Defendant Robert Escobio shall surrender to the headquarters of the U.S. Marshall for the Southern District of Florida, at the Wilkie D. Ferguson U.S. Courthouse, 440 North Miami Avenue, Sixth Floor, Miami, Florida, to thereby be received into United States custody. The surrender shall take place **on or before 12:00 noon on Monday, April 1, 2019**.

It is further **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that the U.S. Marshall for the Southern District of Florida be and is hereby ordered to take the said Defendant Robert Escobio into custody, upon his voluntary surrender, under the provisions of this Court's Order Finding Defendant Robert Escobio in Contempt (D.E. 281).
