REMOVAL OF STAY ORDER

On February 12, 1960, an order was entered in this proceeding (19 Agric. Dec. 65 (19 A.D. 65)) staying the order entered October 12, 1959 (18 Agric. Dec. 1121 (18 A.D. 1121)), pending the outcome of an appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit. The decision and order have been upheld by the court (*Benedict K. Goodman v. Benson*, No. 12920, February 16, 1961) and we have been informed by counsel for respondent here that no further appeal is planned.

Accordingly the stay order of February 12, 1960, is vacated and the order of October 12, 1959, directing all contract markets to refuse all trading privileges to respondent for a period of 20 days shall become effective April 1, 1961.
