
Exhibit E-1 (BSDR Governance and Personnel Chart) Clean

Roles and Responsibilities

President; Vice President

The President and Vice President provide concept leadership, set the strategic direction for the Company's business and oversee the operation of the swap data repository and the Company's overall operations.

Business Manager; Operations Manager

The Business Manager and Operations Manager oversee all aspects of the operation of the company's business. The Business Manager and Operations Manager are responsible for managing the swap data repository in accordance with the strategic direction set by executive management and for maintaining customer relationships. The Business Manager and Operations Manager are responsible for assessing the needs of customers and the industry in general, and for directing the efforts of the Company's Chief Technology Officer, Operations Manager and R&D/Product Development team to meet these needs by way of new or enhanced functions and services. The Business Manager and Operations Manager also manage and oversee all sales and marketing efforts.

Chief Technology Officer; Systems Director

In conjunction with the Business Manager and the Operations Manager, the Chief Technology Officer and the Systems Director oversee the Company's R&D/Product Development Team and direct the process by which the software to be used in conjunction with the swap data repository is written, compiled into executable form and configured on the appropriate hardware. The Chief Technology Officer and the Systems Director are responsible for implementing requests for enhancements to software and responding to software-related issues that arise in connection with the operation of the swap data repository. The Chief Technology Officer and the Systems Director are also responsible for supervising the performance of, system testing and monitoring.

Network Administrator

The Network Administrator monitors the hardware, networks and databases used by the Company in connection with the operation of the swap data repository. The Network Administrator directly controls the hardware that hosts the software to be used in conjunction with the swap data repository. The Network Administrator coordinates with other groups in order to provide support in respect of issues that arise in connection with the hardware, networks and databases used by the Company in connection with the operation of the swap data repository.

Operations Specialist

The Operations Specialist manages responses to customer inquiries. The Operations Specialist resolves reported issues by coordinating with the Business Manager, the Operations Manager, the Chief Technology Officer and the Systems Director.

Chief Compliance Officer; Compliance Officer

The Chief Compliance Officer and Compliance Officer identify the relevant rules, regulations, laws and standards of conduct pertaining to the Company's business and serve as advisers to the Company on matters of compliance with such rules, regulations, laws and standards. Quality Assurance

Web Manager

The Web Manager monitors the operation of the Company website (www.bloombergsdr.com) dedicated to the Company's swap data repository. The Web Manager is responsible for designing and updating the software underlying the website and for troubleshooting technical or support issues that arise with respect to the website. The Web Manager will work in conjunction with the Applicant's technology group and the compliance group to make appropriate updates to website content and function.
