#### Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 21 of the Commodity Exchange Act and Part 49 of the regulations of the Commission, BSDR LLC (the "<u>Applicant</u>"), as proposed operator of a swap data repository, submitted to the Commission a second amended Swap Data Repository Application for Registration on Form SDR dated June 20, 2013 (together with each exhibit thereto, the "<u>Second Amended Application</u>").

On July 3 and July 23, 2013, the staff of the Commission provided the Applicant with certain comments and questions with respect to the duties of the Applicant's Chief Compliance Officer, as laid out in the Second Amended Application (the "CCO Staff Questions"). The Applicant submitted its responses to the CCO Staff Questions (the "CCO Staff Questions Responses"), a third amended Swap Data Repository Application for Registration on Form SDR dated August 2, 2013 ("Third Amended Form SDR") and certain amended exhibits thereto (such amended exhibits, together with the Third Amended Form SDR, the "Third Amended Application"). As requested by the staff of the Commission, the Third Amended Application consists in part of blackline comparisons showing portions of the Third Amended Application marked against corresponding portions of the Second Amended Application.

The Applicant hereby requests that the Confidential Information (as defined below) be accorded confidential treatment on the grounds that it would reveal the Applicant's trade secrets and confidential commercial or financial information. We request this confidential treatment for an indefinite period.
