Re: FOIA Confidential Treatment Request

Dear Sir or Madam:

We have today provided the materials described in Appendix A to this letter (the “Confidential Submission”) to staff of the Division of Market Oversight.

In accordance with the provisions of Commission Regulations 145.5 and 145.9, we hereby request, on behalf of GFI Futures Exchange LLC (“GFI”), confidential treatment of the Confidential Submission and any notes, memoranda or other materials of any type or manner that are made by or at the request of the Commission or its staff and which incorporate, refer or relate to any information contained in the documents referenced in the Confidential Submission. Confidential treatment is requested, *inter alia*, on the grounds that the Confidential Submission contains data and information that would separately disclose business transactions and trade secrets that may not be disclosed to third parties, as provided in Section 8(a) of the Commodity Exchange Act (the “Act”) and Commission Regulation 145.5(c)(1), and on the grounds that the Confidential Submission is exempt from disclosure under paragraph (b)(4) of the Freedom of Information Act and Commission Regulations 145.5(d) and 145.9(d)(1)(ii), because it contains commercial and financial information that is confidential and would be of material assistance to competitors of GFI.


