tpSEF Inc. ("tpSEF") today submitted an amendment to its fee schedule ("Fee Schedule) to the Secretary of U.S. Commodity Futures Trading Commission (the "Commission" or the "CFTC"). This request for FOIA confidential treatment is sought for as long as the Commission remains in control and/or possession of the Confidential Documents, or any notes, memoranda, or other records created by or at the direction of the CFTC, its officers or staff members, that reflect, refer or relate thereto.

We understand that if the Commission receives a FOIA request for Exhibits B and C, tpSEF will be notified of such request in accordance with the Commission's regulations and be asked to submit, within ten business days, a detailed written justification for confidential treatment of the Confidential Documents.

In the event the Commission or its staff provides any of the Confidential Documents to another federal agency, we request that the Commission provide a copy of this letter to such agency with the Confidential Documents and further request that the Commission or its staff inform such agency that tpSEF has requested that this material be accorded confidential treatment.

In addition, please note the accompanying request that your Office acknowledge receipt of the request for confidential treatment, by date-stamping and returning one copy of the enclosed cover letter, in the enclosed self-addressed, postage-prepaid envelope.

Each page of the Confidential Documents has been labelled "Confidential Treatment Requested by tpSEF Inc." and numbered as provided on Schedule A.

Please promptly inform Mr. Brian Donnelly, Chief Compliance Officer, tpSEF Inc. at 101 Hudson Street, Jersey City, NJ 07302, <u>bddonnelly@tullettprebon.com</u>, of any request under FOIA seeking access to the Confidential Documents to enable tpSEF to further substantiate the grounds for confidential treatment.
