NYSE Liffe U.S.- MSCI Emerging Market Mini Index Futures and MSCI EAFE Mini Index Futures – Addition to Trading Month Cycle

Summary

This Notice announces the addition of a fifth delivery month to the established cycle of trading months for MSCI Emerging Market Mini Index Futures and MSCI EAFE Mini Index Futures and the net total return versions of those contracts.

1. Listing of Trading Months

1.1 NYSE Liffe US Notice 19/2009 dated August 28, 2009, which announced the listing of MSCI Emerging Market Mini Index Futures and MSCI EAFE Mini Index Futures, and Notice 21/2010, which announced the listing of the net total return versions of those contracts, provided that NYSE Liffe US (the “Exchange”) will make Delivery Months available for trading on the following basis: At the opening of trading during the Trading Session following the expiration of a Contract, the Exchange will list the next available Delivery Month in the March, June, September and December quarterly cycle so that at the opening of trading for each Trading Session there are four Delivery Months available for trading.

2. Addition of Trading Month

2.1 The Exchange has decided to add a fifth Delivery Month to the cycle of trading months listed for trading. Starting April 8, 2011, the Exchange will list an additional quarterly Delivery Month so that for each Trading Session there will be five Delivery Months available for trading for the following Contracts:
