The Board of Trade of the City of Chicago, Inc. ("CBOT" or "Exchange") hereby notifies the Commodity Futures Trading Commission of its intention to list early the September 2010 contract month for Wheat futures and Mini-Wheat futures. Ordinarily the September 2010 futures contract months would be authorized for trading as of May 15, 2009. Due to customer demand, the Exchange intends to list these contracts earlier than usual (i.e., as of April 17, 2009).

This is a one-time change, rather than a permanent revision, in the Exchange's listing cycle.

CBOT certifies that this change complies with the Commodity Exchange Act and the regulations thereunder.
