Amendment to PBOT Articles of Incorporation

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 5c(c)(1) of the Commodity Exchange Act, as amended ("Act"), and Section 40.6 of the regulations promulgated by the Commodity Futures Trading Commission under the Act, the Philadelphia Board of Trade, Inc. ("PBOT" or "Exchange") hereby submits the attached amendment to the PBOT Articles of Incorporation. The amendment deletes the current requirement in Article 8 of PBOT's Articles of Incorporation which requires authorization by the PBOT Board of Directors to approve any new "commodity" underlying PBOT futures contracts, and reads as follows:

"8. The following corporate action may be taken only if authorized by the board of directors of the corporation: Approval of any "commodity" within the meaning of this term in the Commodity Exchange Act, as amended, with respect to which contracts for future delivery are to be traded on any exchange created by the corporation.

The purpose of deleting the above language from the Articles of Incorporation is to facilitate new listings on the Exchange by eliminating this PBOT Board authorization requirement. The amendment will become effective on April 21, 2008. There were no opposing views among the PBOT's Board of Directors, members or market participants.

PBOT hereby certifies that the attached amendment complies with the Commodity Exchange Act and regulations thereunder.
