The Board of Trade of the City of Chicago, Inc. ("CBOT" or "Exchange") hereby notifies the Commission of its intention to list early the July 2011 and November 2011 Soybean and mini-sized Soybean futures contracts. These futures contracts ordinarily would be authorized for trading as of November 17, 2008. Due to customer demand, the Exchange intends to list these contracts earlier than usual (i.e., as of May 15, 2008).

This is a one-time change, rather than a permanent revision, in the Exchange's listing cycle.

The Exchange certifies that this action neither violates nor is inconsistent with any provision of the Commodity Exchange Act or of the rules thereunder.
