Submission #10-183: Notification of an Administrative Amendment to Chapter 5, Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table of the NYMEX Rulebook to Modify the Commodity Code for the Heating Oil Crack Spread Option Contract

Dear Mr. Stawick:

The New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") is notifying the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") that it is self-certifying an administrative amendment to the Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table located in the Interpretations and Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 of the NYMEX Rulebook to rectify a typographical error relating to the commodity code for the Heating Oil Crack Spread Option contract which is inadvertently inverted in the NYMEX Rulebook's Chapter 5 table. Please note that the correct commodity code continues to be used for large trader reporting.

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Commodity Exchange Act ("Act") and CFTC Rule 40.6, the Exchange hereby certifies that the attached rule amendments comply with the Act, including regulations under the Act. These changes will be made effective on trade date July 1, 2010.
