The purpose for amending Regulation 2011.00. B. is to extend the trading hours for the overnight Hard Red Spring Wheat futures trading session by 75 minutes to 7:15 am. The change is effective with the July 1, 2009 trade date.

2011.00. HOURS OF TRADING.

Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 210.01., the Board of Directors has adopted this Regulation.

The hours of trading at the Minneapolis Grain Exchange shall conform to Central Time.

B. SPRING WHEAT CONTRACT

- 1. The hours of trading in Spring Wheat Futures on MGEXpress® shall be from six o'clock (6:00) p.m. to six-seven-fifteen o'clock (76:1500) a.m. and from nine-thirty o'clock (9:30) a.m. to one-thirty o'clock (1:30) p.m.
- 2. The hours of trading in Spring Wheat Options by open outcry shall be from nine-thirty o'clock (9:30) a.m. to one-thirty o'clock (1:30) p.m.
- 3. The hours of trading in Spring Wheat Options on MGEXpress® shall be from six o'clock (6:00) p.m. to six-seven-fifteen o'clock (67:0015) a.m. and from nine-thirty o'clock (9:30) a.m. to one-thirty o'clock (1:30) p.m.
