Dear Mr. Stawick:

The Board of Trade of the City of Chicago, Inc. ("CBOT" or "Exchange") hereby notifies the Commodity Futures Trading Commission of its intention to delay the listing of the September 2011 Rough Rice options. Ordinarily the September 2011 option month would be authorized for trading as of July 26, 2010. Due to proposed rules changes to the Rough Rice futures the listing of the September 2011 futures contract was delayed awaiting approval. Once the changes have been approved both the September 2011 futures and options will be listed.

This is a one-time change, rather than a permanent revision, in the Exchange's listing cycle.

CBOT certifies that these changes comply with the Commodity Exchange Act and regulations thereunder.
