The New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. ("NYMEX" or "Exchange") is notifying the Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC" or "Commission") that it is self-certifying a revision to its original submission #09-116 previously filed with the Commission on July 29, 2009. Under this rule certification, the Exchange is modifying the listing of the first contract month for the eleven basis option contracts listed below such that the first contract months to be listed shall be the September 2009 delivery months rather than the August 2009 delivery months. As per the original submission #09-116, these options will be listed for trading on Sunday August 2, 2009 for trade date Monday, August 3, 2009 and will be listed for the balance of the current calendar year plus three additional calendar years, up to 48 months, consecutively.
