Dear Mr. Stawick:

The Board of Trade of the City of Chicago, Inc. ("CBOT" or "Exchange") hereby notifies the Commission of its intention to list early the July and December 2010 Wheat option months and the November 2011 Soybean option month. Ordinarily the July 2010 Wheat option would be authorized for trading as of April 27, 2009, the December 2010 Wheat option would be authorized for trading as of August 24, 2009 and the November 2011 Soybean option would be authorized for trading as of July 26, 2010. Due to customer demand, the Exchange intends to list these contracts earlier than usual (i.e., as of August 18, 2008).

This is a one-time change, rather than a permanent revision, in the Exchange's listing cycle.

The Exchange certifies that these changes comply with the Act and the regulations thereunder.
