Expand Listing Cycle for S&P 500 Stock Price Index Futures Submitted per Sec. 5c(c)(1) of the CEA and Regulation Sec. 40.6(a). CME Submission No.10-327

Dear Mr. Stawick:

Chicago Mercantile Exchange ("CME" or "Exchange") hereby notifies the Commodity Futures Trading Commission of the modified listing cycle for S&P 500 Stock Price Index futures ("S&P 500 futures").

Following the expiration of the December 2010 S&P 500 futures contract on December 17, 2010, the listing cycle for S&P 500 futures will expand to list an additional three (3) December contracts. Currently, the Exchange lists eight (8) quarterly contracts. Under the new listing procedure, the Exchange will list Eight (8) quarterly contracts plus Three (3) additional December contracts. There will then be a total of Five (5) December futures contracts listed for trading. The table below illustrates the new listing cycle:
